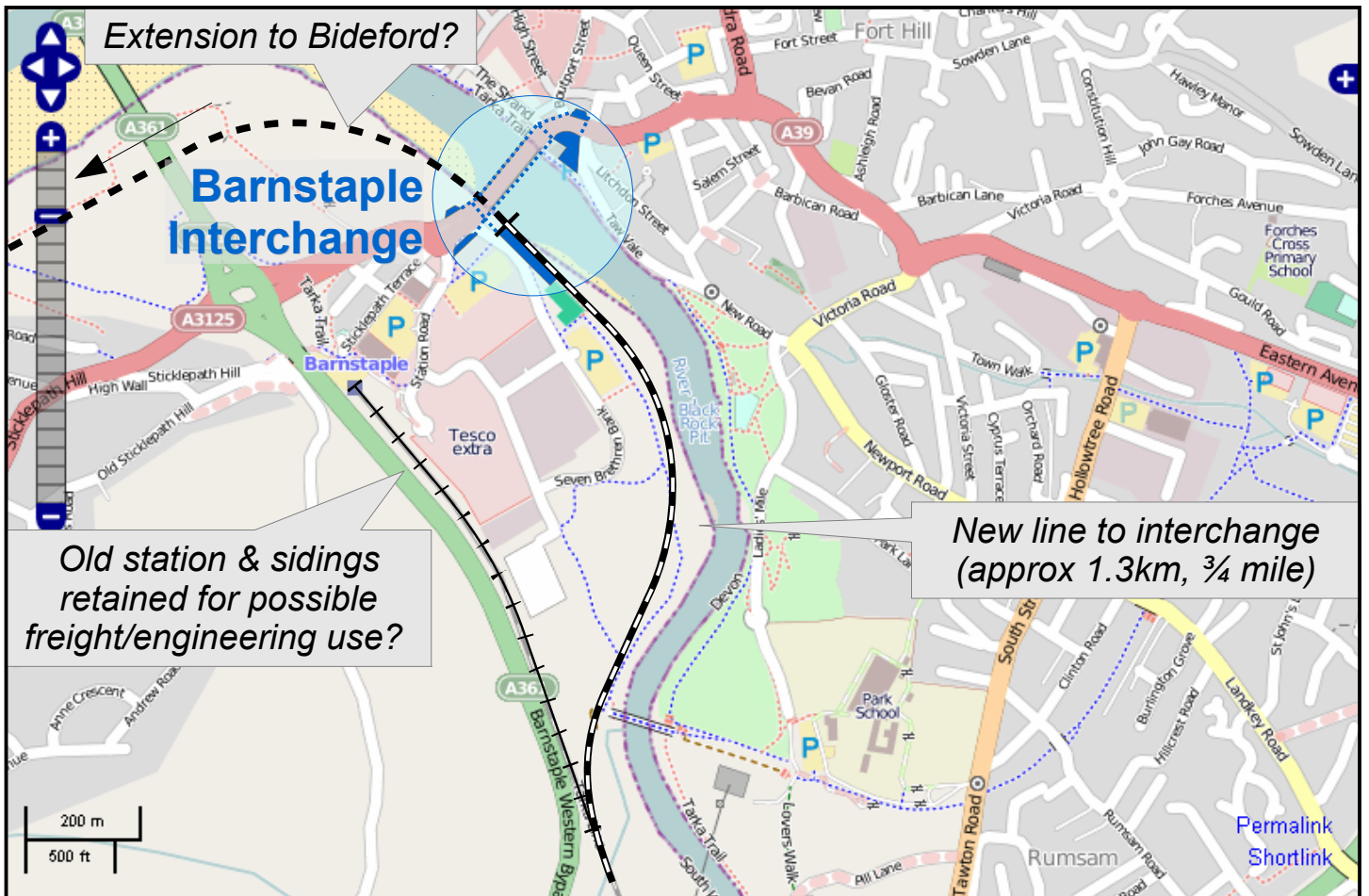


Barnstaple Interchange

A proposal to encourage public transport use by improving interchange between bus and rail modes, and enhancing rail integration to the town centre by reducing walking distance.

Rail Changes

The existing rail station is closed and replaced by a simple single platform at the south end of the town bridge, approached from Exeter by a new railway alignment closely following the south bank of the river Taw. for approximately 1.3km from a junction on the existing line close to the former rail bridge carrying the old connecting lines between GW & LSWR systems, now a cycle & footpath.



Bus Changes

The existing bus station is closed and replaced at the north end of the town bridge in the town clock square. No further from most of the town centre than the existing bus station, the new site is much closer to the new rail platform, only approximately 200m across the river bridge and within clear sight.
